Accessing the Drawing Toolbar

The View menu gives the option of viewing any toolbar for your particular needs.

From the View menu, select Toolbars » Drawing.
The Drawing toolbar appears.

Text Box Create a text box.

Auto Shapes Access a submenu of readymade shapes.
