

Athena Stories: Editing a Story: Content Tab

This article is for editing the Content tab in the Stories app in Athena.

1. Add a featured headline to your story. This will show up on top of the featured image for the story in sliders. This is required.

***Best Practice:** Headline should be clear and specific, telling the reader what the story is about, and be interesting enough to draw them into reading the article.*

2. Add an excerpt to the story (max 255 characters). This is a short description of the story that will be used in listings and featurettes. This is required.
3. Fill in the article of the story. This can include headings, supplemental images, lists, links, accordions, and other basic formatting. Adding images into the article section will yield an image with a name and caption underneath. The name and caption can be [edited in the Athena Images app](#). This will also right-align the image inside the story. The *Article* field is required.
