

Athena Pages: Editing a Page: Redirects Tab

This article is for editing the Redirects tab in the Pages app in Athena. When editing Pages, the Redirects tab allows you to view the current URL and edit redirects for your Page to better sort it on the website. Below are brief descriptions of each box in the Redirects Tab.

1. Edit the **New Redirects** field if you need to set up a redirect.

NOTE: A New Redirect can also be added to direct a new URL to the current document page currently being edited. Please enter the full URL that should redirect here, including https and trailing slash. Note that for technical reasons, the new URL must NOT match any Athena document URLs (beginning with https://www.uwec.edu/files/).
