- [Enterprise and National - Big10 Contract](#) for business use
 - Eligible renters for Business Use: Employees, Consultants and Contractors engaging in active business on behalf of the school. Students at least 18 years and above who are engaging in active business on behalf of the school. 18 - 20-year-old renters are restricted to the following vehicle car classes: Economy, Compact, Intermediate, Standard, Full Size, Minivan, Midsize/Standard SUV Eligible Renters may be required to provide evidence of eligibility at the time of rental
- [Enterprise and National for personal use](#) for drivers 21 years and above
 - Eligible renters for Non-Business Use: Any Employee of the School who wishes to rent for personal use only. Student Organizations or Clubs directly affiliated with the school. Intramural Sports Organizations or Clubs Eligible Renters may be required to provide evidence of eligibility at the time of rental.
